While Bitcoin was already struggling after the collapse of the ICO bubble, its sharp drop on Feb. 6 closely coincided with Kobayashi's major sell-off. Kobayashi denied that his Mt. Gox liquidations deepened the decline, but his actions drew criticism from market observers.

The shift shows that while investors expect the market to remain contained, they are hedging against the risk of a sudden drop.

Recently, though, Bitcoin ETFs have been rebounding after lagging compared to Etheruem ETFs. BTC funds have just recorded two consecutive days of inflows exceeding \$300 million, totaling \$633.3 million across both sessions—the strongest two-day performance since early August.
