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The results could be sending a complex signal to Wall Street, as the two frontrunners represent two vastly different potential futures for artificial intelligence in finance. DeepSeek is reportedly backed by a Chinese quantitative hedge fund, suggesting its success may stem from specialized financial data and expert fine-tuning—an evolutionary step for today's data-driven firms.

Blockchain-based derivatives, not real shares

SearchGPT is the latest development in what appears to be a new era in web search, which The Verge's Nilay Patel has termed "Google Zero." This approach

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prioritizes practicality over variety: instead of presenting a list with different sources and approaches to a specific query, which encourages users to do their own research, AI-powered search engines opt for a more direct tactic, providing concise, summarized information responding exactly to what users are looking for.

However, investors and companies are seeking to get ahead of the problem by urging the adoption of post-quantum cryptography standards before a sufficiently powerful quantum computer emerges.

It urges updating the Bank Secrecy Act to recognize decentralized IDs and zero-knowledge proofs as valid identity-verification methods.
