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Such an integration would create a multimodal AI tool that can handle various types of media and provide comprehensive search results.

“If you want to say that cryptocurrency is this shining horse, ‘an angel from on high,’ you’re bullshitting,” he said. “You have this permissionless open platform that has a lot of different things going on that most people do not understand.”

The six candidates vying for seats on the California Public Employees' Retirement System Board of Administration expressed divided views when asked whether Bitcoin should be included in the \$506 billion fund's portfolio.

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Still, some miners have already announced initiatives to convert facilities with Hut 8 last month revealing plans to develop 1.53 gigawatts of new capacity across four U.S. sites.

Earlier in June, sources close to the matter told Decrypt that FalconX was exploring an initial public offering. The firm had reportedly begun early discussions with advisers about a potential listing within this year.

House of Doge was founded earlier this year to help grow mainstream awareness and adoption of the world's biggest meme coin. Since that time, the firm has collaborated with publicly traded CleanCore on a DOGE treasury chaired by Alex Spiro, the personal lawyer of DOGE-friendly billionaire entrepreneur, Elon Musk.

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
