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“I think that most fiat currencies, especially those with large debts, will have problems being effective storeholds of wealth and will go down in value relative to hard currencies,” he said, pointing to parallels between the coming years and two periods in the 20th century.

Australian self-managed retirement funds held A\$3.02 billion (US\$1.9 billion) in cryptocurrencies at the end of June, but fresh data suggest they largely sat out this year’s digital-asset rally.

If US equities sustain their recovery heading into earnings season, it could create favorable conditions for Bitcoin's own upside revival. A renewed rally in tech and growth stocks, bolstered by easier monetary policy, might help extend "Uptober" optimism into a stronger finish for the month.

Asset manager Franklin Templeton, DBS Bank and Ripple signed a memorandum of understanding in September to launch tokenized trading services on the XRP Ledger (XRPL) built on stablecoins and tokenized money market funds.

Market adoption poses another challenge. It needs to be seen how staking-enabled ETPs perform when competing with Ether ETFs.

Gold, the traditional safe haven asset to which Bitcoin is sometimes compared, was down more than 1% on Wednesday a day after the precious metal registered the largest single-day decline in its history. Gold has hit multiple record highs in recent weeks as investors have turned more risk-averse.

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
