The emergence of smart contracts has brought revolutionary breakthroughs to blockchain technology. These self-executing computer programs can automatically trigger corresponding operations when preset conditions are met, without manual intervention. Smart contracts not only improve transaction efficiency but also greatly reduce trust costs. Currently, smart contracts have been widely applied in decentralized finance (DeFi), digital identity authentication, the Internet of Things, and other fields. With the continuous development of technology, the functions of smart contracts will become more powerful, and application scenarios will become

more abundant.

A tokenized asset, like a stock, bond, or even property, can be held and traded on a blockchain. It can also be fractionalized, meaning that someone could own a tiny sliver of an asset that they couldn't otherwise afford.

In 2017 and 2018, Kobayashi earned the nickname “Tokyo Whale” for selling Mt. Gox Bitcoin to fund fiat repayments. In mid-2024, wallet activity surged again as roughly 100,000 BTC was moved between Mt. Gox addresses for distribution, though not all represented actual sales.

Also, not every coin came from the market; geothermal mining reportedly added around 474 BTC over three years (small in energy terms, but still additive).

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
