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The Financial Conduct Authority estimates that seven million UK adults now hold crypto, up from around 10% (5 million) in 2022 or 4.4% (2.2 million) in 2021, showing the growing interest.

Bitcoin's implied volatility over the next 30 days is holding near 30%, underscoring the recent stretch of subdued price moves.

One such campaign is Algorand, a 13-week onchain questing campaign launched by the layer-1 blockchain Algorand to showcase its ecosystem and technical capabilities. The campaign, which began on Sept. 22, has concluded its third

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week, and the onchain data from its initial phase is now available.

"Bitcoin was easy because it's the gold standard for crypto," the continued. "We believe Trump coin is undervalued, considering that it's the coin backed by the President of the United States, who is not only popular in the United States but a global figure respected and followed all over the world."

"The plan is really to properly and deeply integrate the LimeWire token into what we're doing with Fyre," Zehetmayr told Decrypt. "We definitely want to do some kind of redemption for old holders of tickets as well. I think that's something where you could involve crypto or even NFTs."

As lawmakers propose broader financial regulation, industry groups are increasing their policy engagement.

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
