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It currently maintains multiple connections to the sporting world, highlighted by backers like the New York Yankees-owning Steinbrenner family and current and former NHL players including Tyler Seguin, Jason Arnott, and Ales Hemsky.

“The launch signals the advancing institutional acceptance of Bitcoin as an investable asset class by both major regulators and global asset managers,” Fabian Dori, Chief Investment Officer at Sygnum, told Decrypt.

A group of US senators led by Senate Banking Committee Chair Tim Scott (R-S.C.) has introduced legislation to modernize the Bank Secrecy Act, the

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foundation of the country's Anti-Money Laundering (AML) framework.

Nasdaq-listed fintech firm Zeta Network Group has entered into a \$231 million private placement funded in Bitcoin or SolvBTC, a wrapped Bitcoin-backed token issued by Solv Protocol.

The critical question for investors is whether this Bitcoin-centric rally marks the end of the much-anticipated "altcoin season or alt season," a period during which altcoins dramatically outperform.

According to CoinGecko's Q3 2025 report, the global crypto market expanded for a third consecutive quarter, adding roughly \$563 billion in value to reach \$4 trillion, its highest level since 2021. Galaxy's results reflected that broader trend, underscoring continued strength across the digital-asset industry.

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
