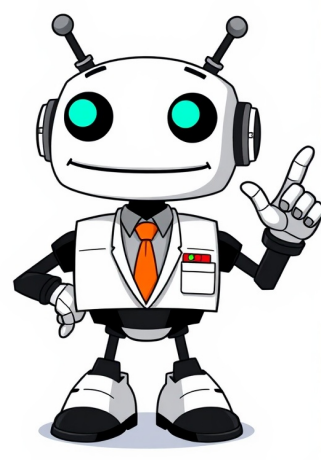

They wanted a traditional home for their young family with great entertaining spaces that took full advantage of the site. The site was far from traditional. The natural grade at the rear of the property was about thirty feet above the street level. Large mature trees provided shade and needed to be preserved. The solution was sectional. The first floor level was elevated from the street by 12 feet, with French doors that provide an outdoor entertaining space, with French doors that open the home to the courtyard. By elevating the first floor level, we were able to allow on-grade parking and a private direct entrance to the lower level pub "Mulligans". An arched passage affords access to the courtyard from a shared driveway with the neighboring homes, while the stone fountain provides a focus. A sweeping stone stair anchors one of the existing mature trees that was preserved and leads to the elevated rear garden. The second floor master suite opens to a sitting porch at the level of the upper garden, providing the third level of outdoor space that can be used for the children to play. The home's traditional language is in context with its neighbors, while the design allows each of the three primary levels of the home to relate directly to the outside. Whom you hire: The cost to clean a house can vary based on whom you hire. Working with an individual cleaner versus a small business or large cleaning company may impact rates, as can working with cleaners who specialize in green cleaning or other specialty cleaning. If you work with a larger company, you may also be sent multiple cleaners to clean your home, which can impact rates. Where you live: As with many services, where you live will impact the rate of your cleaning project. In some areas, hiring someone to clean your home is more expensive. Some services may charge a traveling fee if you live outside of their cleaning area. The frequency of cleaning: How often a home is cleaned may impact the type of cleaning you'll need as well as the price to clean the house. For example, a professional cleaning service may charge differently for weekly, biweekly, monthly or one-time cleanings, both because how much cleaning needs to be done may change and because they may offer discounts to repeat customers. Special requests: Requesting that a cleaner use only eco-friendly cleaning products, clean a home with pets, be especially sensitive to homeowner allergies and more can add to the cost of the cleaning job. Additionally, asking a cleaner to do laundry or wash dishes may impact the cleaning fee. Difficult items to clean: Home-cleaning services may charge additional fees for challenging-to-clean or hard-to-reach items, including the inside of an oven or fridge, blinds, tall ceilings or shelves, fragile collections, fireplaces, windows and more. The rooms you have cleaned: You may hire a cleaner to clean only a portion of your home, such as living areas only, which can result in a lower cleaning fee. If you choose to have a biweekly cleaning, for example, you can alternate which rooms you have cleaned each time the cleaner visits. If you go with an independent cleaner, you will likely deal directly with the person who will be cleaning your house. Because of this, there may be more flexibility with timing and pricing. If you choose to repeatedly hire this cleaner, you may develop more of a personal working relationship. As you will be working with the cleaner directly, it will be up to you to check their credentials, insurance and bonding, and perhaps deal with other logistics, including tax withholding. If you choose to hire a cleaning service, the service should handle insurance (in case anyone is injured while cleaning your house) and bonding (which would repay you if anything was damaged or undelivered), leaving you to worry solely about paying for the cleaning. While a service could be more expensive than an individual cleaner, as there is more overhead to pay for, should things go wrong, you may have less responsibility.
