It usually shows up after a router reset, power outage, or software update. Sometimes, the printer works fine one day and disappears from your network the next. When this happens, you may notice your computer says the printer is offline, even though its on. Print jobs might stay stuck in the queue. Or the printer may not show up at all when you try to add it again. In many cases, the printer, router, and computer. Unplug each for at least 30 seconds. Then plug them back in and turn them on. This clears cached settings and restarts your network. Once everything boots up, check if the printer reconnects. Many issues disappear after a full reset. Go to the printers settings menu and choose Wireless Setup or Network Settings. Select your WiFi name and enter the password is correct; even one to ne printer settings menu and choose Wireless Setup or Network Settings. wrong letter will stop the connection. If your printer supports WPS, you can also press the WPS button on your router and then on the printer to reconnect without entering a password. Log in to your router (usually by typing 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1 in your browser). Look for the list of connected devices. If your printer isnt listed, its not connected. Check that the routers WiFi isnt using a band your printer doesnt support. Many older printers dont work with 5 GHz networks and need 2.4 GHz. You can enable both bands on most routers. Printers network settings and assign it an IP address manually. You can also set a DHCP reservation in the router so the printer always gets the same address. Go to the printer scan update over WiFi if they connect again briefly. On your computer, uninstall the printer completely, the reinstall it with the latest software. Outdated drivers can cause detection issues. If nothing works, try connecting the printer to your computer with a USB cable. This isnt ideal for wireless setups but can confirm whether the printer itself is still functional. If a wired connection works and WiFi doesnt, the wireless module may be faulty. Some newer printers handle reconnections much better. If youve had recurring problems, consider replacing your current model. Look for these on Amazon: HP Envy Inspire series Brother HL-L2395DW Epson EcoTank ET-2850 These have strong wireless features and easier setup tools. Router resets, IP changes, or signal issues are common causes. Yes. Weak signals cause dropped connections. Keep them in the same room if possible. As a last resort. This will erase all settings. Only if the printer supports WiFi Direct or Bluetooth. And that is how to fix printer not connecting to Wi-Fi anymore, and why it might be happening. In summary, this printer not connecting to WiFi issue can be fix by either updating printer firmware and drivers, getting a printer that reconnect easily, or switching to a wired or USB connection. Or even checking the router settings; in some cases setting a static IP for the print also works.
