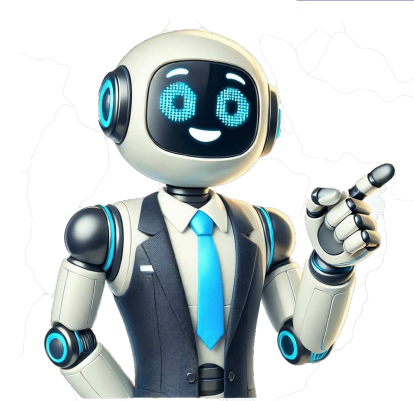

Spring Semester: Final Exam Schedule - Spring 2025 Summer Semester: Final exams take place the last day of class. Online Courses: Exams for fully online classes must be online. If the course has 100% of its course delivery online, it cannot have a mandatory in-person final exam. Instructors should notify the Registrar's office if they have an exam scheduled but will not need it. It is important that the Registrar's office has an accurate final exam schedule available in case of emergency. Please email academicscheduling@ilstu.edu if an exam needs to be cancelled. Instructors may request a change to their final exam date/time in extenuating circumstances. Instructors should make arrangements for any student with a conflict due to the new exam time. Email academicscheduling@ilstu.edu with exam change requests. Final exams cannot be scheduled during Success Week (week prior to final exam week) per Policy 4.1.5 Final Examinations. Instructors may request an extended exam time if their course is 4+ credit hours, however, arrangements must be made if the extended time causes a conflict for their students. Exams Rescheduled by Illinois State If a situation occurs that causes the University to close (such as weather), final exams will be canceled and rescheduled for the Friday of final exams week. Same times and locations apply. Exam/Quiz requests must be submitted at least 3 business days before the exam date. Saturday and Sunday are not business days. As a helpful way to remember when to submit requests, use the following: If your exam is on Monday, your request is due by 11:55 p.m. on the Wednesday before the exam. If your exam is on Tuesday, your request is due by 11:55 p.m. on the Thursday before the exam. If your exam is on Wednesday, your request is due by 11:55 p.m. on the Friday before the exam. If your exam is on Thursday, your request is due by 11:55 p.m. on the Monday before the exam. If your exam is on Friday, your request is due by 11:55 p.m. on the Tuesday before the exam. Final Exam Deadline The deadline to submit requests for final exams is typically 4 weeks before final exam week. Each semester, you will receive notification via your ISU email of the deadline to schedule your final exams. Late requests are not accepted for final exams. Please make sure you are checking your ISU email consistently. For all questions/concerns regarding exams, contact the Exams Office at saasexams@ilstu.edu Night exams may be scheduled for a multi-sectioned course if a common departmentally developed examination will be administered to all students in the course at the same time, and test scores will be used as a basis for uniform grading for all sections of the course. Night exam requests must be approved by the Provost and announced in the Schedule of Classes. Night exams do not apply to any distance education course sections. Whenever a night exam is administered, a regular class meeting during that week will be omitted. Students who are unable to take a night exam at a scheduled time because of a course conflict or other legitimate reason must notify the instructor in advance and must be given the opportunity to be examined at another time mutually convenient for the student and the instructor. The instructor will determine whether to administer the same exam or an alternate exam, or use an alternate assessment procedure. Students who have two or more night exams scheduled on the same calendar day and time may request to reschedule a night exam. The instructor of the course having the smallest number of students is responsible for arranging an alternate examination time for the student unless make-up exam times are available in one of the other courses. Graduate faculty who want to administer a night examination should work directly with Room Scheduling to ensure that a room is available. Final Exams No special times are set for summer final exams, contact your instructor for more information. Final exams in courses of two or more credits may not be given at a time that differs from the exam as scheduled by the registrar. An instructor may not give a final exam week nor change the published time final examination as it appears in the final exam schedule. Permission to change the time for which an exam is scheduled may be given only by the dean of the college. If the instructor elects not to give a final exam, the class is required to meet at the scheduled final exam period for other educational activity such as a review of the course or feedback on previous exams. With the exception of special group courses, time for examinations is determined by the student's first contact (beginning of class time) of the week in each course. Special group exams will be scheduled after the semester begins if appropriate exam times and rooms can be arranged. When using this tentative schedule, refer to the list of probable special group exam courses. This list of group exam courses is subject to change. For courses which are all recitation or lecture, or which have one or more recitations or lectures with one or more laboratories, the first recitation or lecture of the week is considered as the first contact of the week. In courses having both recitations and lectures, the department head may determine whether the first lecture or the first recitation is to be considered the first contact. When determining first contact hour, look for the beginning of class time in the ranges listed. For example, if the first contact time is Mon. 11:00 a.m., look for Mon. 10:30-11:29 a.m. Courses with lectures scheduled at 6:00 p.m. or later should give their examinations during finals week from 7:00-9:00 p.m. on the day the class normally meets. Courses with a first contact hour not listed on the exam schedule are to have examinations during finals week at a time to be announced by the instructor once rooms are secured through Room Scheduling. Examples include courses with a first contact time on Tuesday between 11:30-12:29 p.m., classes with first contact time on Mon. or Tues. between 4:30 - 5:59 p.m., or courses with a first contact time on a Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday. For courses that are not listed on the exam schedule, the exam time is to be announced by the instructor. If the instructor arranged exam time causes a student to have two exams at the same time, the student may request to reschedule the instructor arranged final exam. The instructor of the arranged exam is responsible for offering an alternate examination time for the student unless make-up exam times are available in the other course. To reschedule, the student must notify the instructor prior to the last day of class before the beginning of prep week so the instructor has time to make appropriate arrangements. Examinations will be held in the meeting place of the first contact of the week, except those in special groups. For the special groups, the place will be announced by the instructor. Students who have three or more finals on the same calendar day may request to reschedule a final. The instructor of the course having the smallest number of students is responsible for arranging an alternate examination time for the student unless make-up exam times are available in one of the other courses. To reschedule, the student must notify the instructor prior to the last day of class before the beginning of prep week so the instructor has time to make appropriate arrangements. Final exams will be held in their regularly assigned classroom with the exception of courses with a common exam date and time. For common exams please check with instructor for classroom assignment.
