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For students transferring from NMSU Community College campuses, they must submit the Change of Campus Request Form and meet certain GPA and course completion requirements, such as a 2.0 cumulative GPA, 24 completed college credit hours, and completion of specific courses like CCDE 110N or ENGL 1110G. NMSU Global Campus also offers reduced tuition rates for active-duty service members, veterans, and dependents, with additional credit granted for military training. A university system is a designation granted to an institution that meets specific requirements as set by the Commission on Higher Education. It comprises separate yet interconnected units, with at least one possessing university-level status. A single governing board oversees system-wide policies and programs, while each constituent unit has its own chief executive officer with broad powers. In Vietnam, university systems consist of numerous member institutions, each equivalent to a regular specialized university. The country currently boasts six university systems, each divided into multiple universities, schools, or institutes specializing in specific disciplines. The head of a university system is referred to as the president, whereas the head of a member university is called the rector. In France, there are two legal statuses for grouping universities: the collegiate university and the university system. The former is often adopted by merging at least two universities, while the latter allows universities to retain their autonomy within an association. MARA System is part of De La Salle Philippines, which has 16 campuses as its own entity. Other notable university systems mentioned include Mindanao State University System with 8 constituent universities, St. Paul University System with 7 campuses, and University of Perpetual Help System with 4 DALTA campuses. The list also includes several other international university systems such as National Taiwan University System, University System of Taipei, Rajabhat University system in Thailand, Vietnam National University, Hanoi, and Vietnam National University, Ho Chi Minh City. In France, the mentioned universities include University of Lyon, University of Normandy, and University of Toulouse. Other notable mentions are State University System of Greece, National University of Ireland with 4 constituent universities, England's University of London with 17 constituent colleges, Scotland's University of the Highlands and Islands with 13 colleges and institutes. In South America, there is Federal University of Technology - Paraná, São Paulo State University, Bahia State University, and State University of Western Paraná. Additionally, Anahuac University Network is mentioned, which has 8 campuses throughout Mexico and some allied institutions in other countries. Ana G. The University of California system, a prestigious public university system in the US, operates independently from its counterpart system. Several other states have their own comprehensive systems, including Alabama, Alaska, Arizona, Arkansas, Colorado, Connecticut, Florida, Georgia, Hawaii, Illinois, Louisiana, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, New Hampshire, New York, North Carolina, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, Pennsylvania. Degree offerings include a Master of Arts program with application deadlines for Fall and Spring semesters. Admission process varies by program, but typically occurs once a year in the fall semester, with application deadlines as follows: - Master of Fine Arts: February 1st or December 15th - Master of Science: March 1st for Thesis-MS, no specific deadline for Non-Thesis-MS and rolling applications - Master of Arts: No specific deadline, processing occurs in the following semester - Master of Arts (Online): No specific deadline, processing occurs in the following semester - Master of Data Analytics: No specific deadline, only admits for Fall and Spring Semesters No specific deadlines exist for most application processes, which typically occur on a semester-by-semester basis.
