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Kobayashi's Feb. 6 sale also coincided with Bitcoin's slide to around \$6,000, which was the lowest point of that year's first quarter. Bitcoin was already falling from its December 2017 peak of nearly \$20,000 during the height of the initial coin offering (ICO) boom.

“The bottom line is, unless there is an audience for this, there’s no future,” he said. “I’m not an expert in almost anything, but there’s one thing that I can say I have at least a little bit of knowledge in, and that’s video. I’ve made so many.”

The researchers used Metaplanet, the fourth-largest Bitcoin treasury firm, as an example, as the company effectively transformed a market capitalization of \$8 billion, supported by just \$1 billion in Bitcoin holdings, into a \$3.1 billion market cap backed by \$3.3 billion in BTC.

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
