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“For ETH on the September 12 expiry, we see almost 10% of volume in the last 48 hours on the \$3600, \$3800 puts as traders brace for a sharp pullback,” he said.

Grayscale Ethereum Trust (ETHE) and Grayscale Ethereum Mini Trust (ETH) are spot Ether ETPs that now support onchain staking. Grayscale Solana Trust (GSOL) has also enabled staking while trading over the counter. Together, these offerings are the first US-listed products to combine spot crypto exposure with staking rewards.

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The executive did emphasize, though, her confidence that Custodia has already been deemed a “legally eligible entity” by the Fed.

Still, the partnership opens a way for institutions to “transform idle BTC from a passive store of value into a dynamic, flexible on-chain asset,” that users could, in turn, engage with for yield-generating opportunities, Ryan Chow, CEO of Solv Protocol, told Decrypt.

On Tuesday, a coalition of fintech and crypto trade groups, including the Blockchain Association and Crypto Council for Innovation, submitted their own letter urging the CFPB to affirm, “Americans own their financial data, not big banks.”

Meanwhile, Jim Harper, a non-resident Senior Fellow with the public policy think tank the American Enterprise Institute, had a different approach.

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
