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A repeatable pre-screen process forces discipline: You filter out hype-only tokens, highlight projects with verifiable fundamentals and cut down the time wasted chasing every rumor.

"As the UK crypto investor base is projected to approach 4 million over the next year, today's listing of exchange-traded products like iShares Bitcoin ETP unlock a securer gateway to digital assets through traditional investment platforms," the firm's EMEA head of global product Jane Sloan said, speaking to the FT.

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"The bill ensures that the companies driving up New Yorkers' electricity rates pay their fair share, while providing direct relief to families struggling with rising utility costs," Senator Krueger said in a statement when S8518 was introduced.

Senator Pete Ricketts, who supports the bill, said, "After more than 50 years of inflation, the Bank Secrecy Act's reporting thresholds are badly outdated. They must be modernized."

"We recently contracted for additional power and real estate in College Park to deliver high-value compute to the greater Atlanta metro area and are evaluating giga-campus opportunities across the portfolio and pipeline that are well positioned to satisfy significant off-taker demand."

Ethereum could eventually surpass Bitcoin's market share in a similar manner to how US equities overtook gold 54 years ago, when the US abandoned the gold standard, according to BitMine chair Tom Lee.

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
