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Investors sank about \$477 million and \$142 million into the Bitcoin and Ethereum funds, respectively, last week, according to U.K. asset manager Farside Investors.

This technological progress has fueled the continued adoption of stablecoins, fiat-pegged digital tokens that can move across the internet without relying on traditional payment rails. The report cited \$9 trillion in stablecoin transactions over the past 12 months — an 87% increase from the previous year.

Wallets tied to Chen Zhi, a Chinese and Cambodian national allegedly at the center of a global pig butchering crypto scam network, moved nearly \$2 billion worth of Bitcoin from wallets recently sanctioned by the U.S. Treasury Department to new addresses, according to analysis from Arkham Intelligence.
