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“If I remember correctly, he went on a rampage posting several 'Floki as X CEO' tweets and memes shortly after, and was even excitedly talking about how it's cool that his dog was running Twitter on mainstream TV,” pseudonymous trader Bonk Guy wrote on X. “[It] would be ironic if we get a repeat! Time is a flat circle, as they say.”

“The launch signals the advancing institutional acceptance of Bitcoin as an investable asset class by both major regulators and global asset managers,” Fabian Dori, Chief Investment Officer at Sygnum, told Decrypt.

Big Tech firms have also been supportive: Microsoft accepts BTC directly or through processors, whereas Newegg also supports ETH for purchases on-site, and Overstock welcomes XRP as well. AMC Theatres accepts Bitcoin and other digital assets for its products and services, from Xbox content to movie tickets.

Surprisingly, the company added that retail long positioning is inversely correlated with price, at -0.86 for ETH, implying that as retail longs reach extreme highs, the likelihood of a reversal grows.

In a Tuesday note, analysts at investment bank Compass Point noted that Galaxy's earnings before interest and taxes came in 236% above Wall Street estimates. They added that the increase in assets on Galaxy's platform will likely cause investors to adjust forecasts higher.

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
