ETFs recorded \$40.47 million in net outflows on Monday, their fourth consecutive day of withdrawals. BlackRock's IBIT led the losses, shedding \$100.65 million, while Fidelity's FBTC and Bitwise's BITB posted inflows of \$9.67 million and \$12.05 million, respectively.

Bitcoin mining company stocks rocketed up Monday as Bitcoin and other cryptocurrencies rallied amid increased optimism that the U.S. and China would find at least a partial resolution to its trade war.

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The results could be sending a complex signal to Wall Street, as the two frontrunners represent two vastly different potential futures for artificial intelligence in finance. DeepSeek is reportedly backed by a Chinese quantitative hedge fund, suggesting its success may stem from specialized financial data and expert fine-tuning—an evolutionary step for today's data-driven firms.

Three whales returned to decentralized exchange Hyperliquid on Wednesday, depositing tens of millions of dollars to initiate leveraged long positions, which use “borrowed” funds to increase the size of the investment.

Trading volumes jumped 140% from the previous quarter, fueled by increased spot and derivatives volumes. The quarter included the execution of a major client transaction involving the sale of more than 80,000 Bitcoin (BTC) — one of the largest crypto trades to date.
